



Instructions


1. Send file to printer. If you're printer does not automatically print on both sides, see step 2.
2. When this side is finished printing, take out of the tray and put it back into the blank paper feed.
3. Make sure printed side is up, blank side is down, and black bar feeds into the printer first.
4. Printing all done, just cut along the grey outlines with scissors or a paper cutter, and enjoy!

DIPLODOCUS (dip-low-doe-kus)

15 tons = 3 African Elephants






- * Dippy is a close cousin of the Apatosaurus, Ajax. They're both in the family *Diplodocidae*.
- * With new fossil facts, most paleontologists think Diplodocus and other sauropods held their heads up high, instead of straight out.

APATOSAURUS (ah-pah-toe-sore-us)

20 tons = 4 African Elephants






- * Apatosaurus are often called Brontosaurus by mistake. They're different, but related, like goats and sheep.
- * Apatosaurus and other sauropods had hollow bones with air sacs, just like birds!

ALLOSAURUS (al-low-sore-us)

1500 lbs. = Holstein Cow






- * Allosaurus were the most common predator in Jurassic North America.
- * Allosaurus doesn't have the bone-crushing jaws T-rex, but who needs that when your teeth are like a built in bone-saw?

BRACHIOSAURUS (brack-ee-oh-sore-us)

25 short tons = 5 African Elephants or 1 Humpback Whale






- * The "Brachiosaurus" in *Jurassic Park* is really an African cousin called Giraffatitan.
- * Brachiosaurus had column-like legs to support its body, and its front feet left tracks shaped like a horse-shoe. It only had one "thumb" claw.

ARCHAEOPTERYX (ar-key-opp-ter-icks)

2 lbs. = 4 8oz bottles or 1 guinea pig






- * Archaeopteryx is not the first bird, Aurornis is an early bird from Jurassic China, found in rocks *older* than Archaeopteryx.
- * Archaeopteryx, like all birds, is a dinosaur. Tango happens to be near the base of the *birds' branch* on the tree.

STEGOSAURUS (steg-oh-sore-us)

3000 lbs. = 2 Holstein Cows

- * Stegosaurus had only one brain, not two, which was about the size of a hotdog.
- * Stegosaurus had secret bony armor under the skin, and a layer of horn covered the spikes and plates.
